

Spree Celebration Sunday Resources

We are so excited for all that God wants to do in the lives of children and young people over SPREE SW 2026. We would love to encourage churches to host a SPREE Sunday on the Sunday after SPREE which this year is the 5th July. This is a great opportunity to encourage and share with your whole church family what SPREE was all about and get your children and young people involved in leading this. Below are some ideas to help you to do this when you get home.

Overview

SPREE SW Celebration Service (Youth & Kids Led Service)

Key Verse: "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!" – 1 John 3:1

Service Aim - To celebrate God's unstoppable love, recognise our identity as His children, and commission all generations to share His love with the world.

Song

Our worship leaders have got together and written a worship song called Unstoppable based on the theme of Spree this year. This song is now available on Spotify but we have also provided below the sheet music. We would love you to encourage your worship leaders in your church to teach this to your congregation as the children and young people get back as part of this special service .

Video

We will be producing and sending you a SPREE Highlights video approximately 90 seconds long which we would love you to show as a part of the service to help people to see what the weekend was like for all involved. This video will be sent to the main group leaders by Friday after SPREE SW.

Devotional

Finally this year we have produced two 4 week long devotionals for 8-12 year olds and 13-17 year olds. These have been written to try and help with follow up after the event, to embed the teaching from the weekend but also help to encourage daily good habits. We'd love to encourage your church to consider how you encourage this from using these through youth and kid's groups through July, you could encourage adults to use them too for housegroups or personally or to refer to them in services in July. These will be given out on the Sunday of SPREE to all the children and young people.



Thank you so much for bringing your group to SPREE - The weekend is an amazing experience for children and young people but our hope is that it is just a catalyst for so much more than just a weekend. We love to hear stories throughout the year of changed lives and trust that once again this year we will hear and see children and young people making life long decisions to follow Jesus all of their days. Thank you for everything you have done as a church to enable this to happen and we trust this SPREE Sunday would be a real encouragement to your whole church family.

Potential Service Structure



Welcome (3 mins)

Led by 2 young people/children. Welcome everyone. Brief explanation that today's service is being led by the children and young people who attended SPREE SW.

Opening Prayer

"Today we gather as one church family to celebrate God's unstoppable love. A love that could not be stopped by death, a love that calls us His children, and a love that flows through us to the world."

Opening Worship (12–15 mins)

Led by Youth Worship Team or seeking to involve children and young people in this.

Teach the congregation 'Unstoppable' – Why not send out the track beforehand for the congregation to listen to aid the learning. Encourage energetic participation and celebration.

Interactive Icebreaker: What Can't Be Stopped? (5 mins)

Invite children and adults to suggest things that seem unstoppable for example:

- The tide - A train - A waterfall - The sun rising

Leader: "Even greater than all of these is God's love. Nothing can stop His love reaching us."

SPREE SW Highlights Video (2-3 mins)

Show SPREE Highlights Video (this will be sent out during the week after SPREE)

Maybe add your own church pics or video after this.

Testimonies (10–12 mins)

Invite 3–5 young people of different ages to share (each testimony 2-3 mins)

- Favourite moment from SPREE SW - What they learned about God - How God challenged or encouraged them
- OR... "What Did We Learn?"

Children and young people come to the front and answer simple questions:

- What was the theme? - What Bible story/verse stood out? - What did you learn about Jesus? - What are you taking home with you?

Bible Reading (2 mins)

"See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!" – 1 John 3:1

Short Message (8–10 mins)

Delivered by Youth Leader or Youth Person

Title: "Don't Keep It to Yourself"

Key points:

1. God did amazing things at SPREE SW.
2. God wants us to remember what He has done.
3. God wants us to share our faith with others.
4. Following Jesus continues after the event ends.

Challenge:

"What is one way God's unstoppable love could flow through me to someone else this week?"

Response Activity (10 mins)

Provide cards or sticky notes. Prompt: "One thing God has taught me is..." or "This week I want to..."

Invite people to:

- Write a prayer or write a thank you to God or write a commitment

Play quiet music while people respond.

Prayers of Thanksgiving (5 mins)

Led by children and young people. You could use this prayer...

'Almighty God, We thank You for all that happened at SPREE SW this year. Thank You for the fun, the friendships, the laughter, the worship, and the opportunities to learn more about You. Thank You for Your unstoppable love—a love that came into the world through Jesus, a love that reaches every person, a love that nothing can defeat or take away. Thank You that You call us Your children and give us an identity that is secure in You.

Lord, we pray for every child, young person, leader, and volunteer who was part of SPREE. Help the truths they discovered this last weekend to take deep root in their hearts. When they return to school, work, and everyday life, remind them that they are loved by You and never alone. Help us to respond to Your love with hearts full of worship, gratitude, and trust. May we love You because You first loved us. And Father, let Your unstoppable love overflow through us into our families, our schools, our neighbourhoods, and our church. Help us to show kindness, compassion, forgiveness, and courage so that others may see Jesus in us.

Where there is darkness, let Your love bring light. Where there is hurt, let Your love bring healing. Where there is division, let Your love build bridges. Where there is doubt, let Your love bring hope. Make us part of Your unstoppable movement of love that changes lives and points people to Christ. We ask all this in the name of Jesus, whose love conquered sin and death and continues to transform the world. Amen.'

Closing Worship (8 mins)

Commissioning & Sending (5 mins)

Leader: "God's love doesn't stop here. We are sent to carry His love into our schools, homes, workplaces, and communities."

Invite everyone to stretch out their hands.

Prayer: "Father, fill us with your unstoppable love.

Help us know we are your children and empower us to share your love with the world. In Jesus' name. Amen."

Take-Home Challenge

During the coming week:

- Show God's love to one person.
- Pray for one friend.
- Share one act of kindness.

Ask: "How will God's unstoppable love flow through you this week?"



**Other Ideas

1. Creatively thanking the volunteer team perhaps with children and young people thanking and praying for them – You could encourage young people to give volunteer special awards
2. Creatively thanking the church for their financial support and prayers
3. Mini-Spree's Got Talent activity – Why not get some of the congregation up to showcase their talent!
